Research Analysis

The committee substitute to HB 3078 requires executive branch entities to include a method for donations to be made to the to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) Revolving Fund on its forms and online payment platforms. The donation link or method must be included on the following:

- Driver license applications;
- Motor vehicle registrations and renewals;
- Fishing and hunting license applications;
- Income tax forms; and
- Any other transaction in which an executive agency issues a license or utilizes a form that could contain a donation link.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3078 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) to accept donations by adding a donation option to existing forms on certain government websites. Donations will be deposited into the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs Revolving Fund to support veteran care.

ODVA anticipates minimal implementation costs by leveraging existing systems and projects strong revenue potential from voluntary contributions. In its current form, HB 3078 is expected to have a negligible impact on the FY27 state budget, with actual revenue dependent on annual donation levels.
