**Research Analysis**

HB 3078 as introduced requires executive governmental entities to include a conspicuous check box or similar method to allow a person making a payment to specified government entities the option to make a donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs Revolving Fund.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3078 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) to accept donations by adding an option to existing forms on certain government websites. The measure adds a donation option to forms individuals already use on certain government websites. Donations will be deposited into the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs Revolving Fund to support veteran care.

ODVA anticipates minimal implementation costs by leveraging existing systems and projects strong revenue potential from voluntary contributions. In its current form, HB 3078 is expected to have a negligible impact on the FY27 state budget, with actual revenue dependent on annual donation levels.
