Impact:	ODVA: Potential Unknown Revenue Increase

Research Analysis

The policy recommendation to HB 3078 requires state entities organized within the executive department to include on any forms a link to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) to allow a person making a payment to those entities to make a donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veteran Affairs Revolving Fund. The provisions of the section specifically apply to:

- Driver license applications;
- Motor vehicle registrations and renewals;
- Fishing and hunting license applications;
- Income tax forms; and
- Any other transaction in which an executive agency issues a license or utilizes a form that could contain information prescribed in the section.

Any payment for any item or service described in this section made through a website owned or maintained on behalf of a government entity must provide a conspicuous method for making a donation to the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) Revolving Fund.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3078 authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs (ODVA) to accept donations by adding a donation option to existing forms on certain government websites. Donations will be deposited into the Oklahoma Department of Veterans Affairs Revolving Fund to support veteran care.

ODVA anticipates minimal implementation costs by leveraging existing systems and projects strong revenue potential from voluntary contributions. In its current form, HB 3078 is expected to have a negligible impact on the FY27 state budget, with actual revenue dependent on annual donation levels.
