**Research Analysis**

HB 3081 as introduced, lowers the age a person can apply for a fire extinguisher industry business license from 21 to 18. Applicants are no longer required to include a photograph of themselves or a statement of the scope of their businesses in their application. Fingerprints are no longer required for individual applications. Fire extinguisher business licenses, initial individual licenses, individual renewal licenses, and fire extinguisher business renewal licenses are valid for one year.
