Research Analysis

HB3087, as introduced, increases the allowed response times for proceedings related to garnishee orders to 30 days. Please see the table below for the affected proceedings and their current deadlines:

Amended Procedure	Current Deadline	Proposed Deadline
Defendant's window to file written objection for summons	5 days	30 days
Court deadline to hear and decide defendant's motion to quash	5 days	30 days
Garnishee's answer/remittance deadline	7 days after the end of defendant's pay period or 30 days from the date of service of the summons, whichever is earlier	30 days
Continuing earnings garnishment answer and remittance deadline	7 days after the end of defendant's pay period or 30 days from the date of service of the summons, whichever is earlier	30 days
Garnishee affidavit filing deadline	7 days after the end of defendant's pay period or 30 days from the date of service of the summons, whichever is earlier	30 days
Garnishee's deadline to comply with court orders	7 days	30 days
