Fiscal Analysis

The measure in its current form would alter the funding methodology for the concurrent enrollment program within the Oklahoma State Regents for Higher Education. Currently, the program is funded by an appropriation from the Legislature after being provided a dollar figure by the Regents in their budget request.

This measure would create a Concurrent Enrollment Trust Fund, or revolving fund, within the CLO where any funds that are appropriated by the Legislature, gifts, grants, or otherwise donated would be the source for initial capitalization of the Trust fund. Similar to the Permanent School Fund, the Trust would then disburse the income generated annually to the Regents for the purposes of funding concurrent enrollment. For reference, the total appropriated amount to the Regents for concurrent enrollment was \$20,492,168. Assuming a 5-7% annual return, the corpus would need an initial capitalization of \$400-450 million to generate enough income to fund concurrent enrollment at its current level.
