**Fiscal Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute to HB 3128 creates the Actionable Response for Industry Skills and Excellence in Oklahoma (ARISE-OK) Task Force, comprised of twenty-two (22) members. These members would receive no compensation, but any members who are not state employees shall receive travel reimbursement. Staffing costs will be the responsibility of the Oklahoma Department of Labor. All costs are expected to be minimal and absorbed within existing budgetary resources.
