**Research Analysis**

HB 3144, as introduced, limits, starting Nov. 1, 2026, the total number of medical marijuana grower licenses to 2,500. The measure also repeals [63 O.S. 2021, Section 427.14a](#), which allows OMMA to establish a moratorium on new licenses for medical marijuana.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB 3144 limits the total number of medical marijuana grower licenses that may be approved and issued by the Oklahoma Medical Marijuana Authority (OMMA). While the cap could reduce potential future fee revenue, OMMA has indicated that any additional administrative workload associated with enforcing the license cap can be managed within existing resources. As a result, HB 3144 is not expected to require additional appropriations. The extent of any potential loss in fee revenue remains uncertain.
