**Research Analysis**

The policy committee recommendation to HB 3152 gives Corporation Commission enforcement officers general criminal law enforcement authority upon the prior consent of the official in charge of a state law enforcement agency, sheriff, or chief of police in whose territorial jurisdiction the exercise of such authority occurs.

**Fiscal Analysis**

HB3152 authorizes Corporation Commission enforcement officers to exercise general criminal law enforcement authority upon receiving consent from the appropriate law enforcement official and removes certain search and seizure restrictions. The language is permissive, and any costs associated with the expanded enforcement authority are expected to be absorbed in accordance with the normal duties of the Corporation Commission. Therefore, in its current form, HB3152 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
