**Fiscal Analysis**

This measure increases the sheriff's service fee from certain criminal juvenile proceedings to a maximum of \$150. A portion of these monies may pass through the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) and be remitted to the Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) to provide care and maintenance and to supplement community-based programs. Officials from both the AOC and OJA have stated that they do not anticipate any material impact to the agency's budget. Therefore, in its current form, HB3262 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
