Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3270 permits intentional commingling and integration of farmed and native Cervidae if such deer meet the specifications of the Chronic Wasting Disease Improvement Act. This measure allows the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) to charge a one-time permit fee not exceeding Five Hundred Dollars (\$500.00) for citizens purchasing deer meeting the specified requirements.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3270 clarifies that deer that meet the specifications of the Chronic Wasting Disease Genetic Improvement Act are exempt from the intentional commingle provisions of the Oklahoma Farmed Cervidae Act. The measure also transfers a potential one-time permit fee from the Oklahoma Department of Wildlife Conservation (ODWC) to the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF) charged to citizens purchasing deer as a result of the criteria established within the Chronic Wasting Disease Genetic Improvement Act pilot program. Upon review, this transfer is expected to result in a minimal revenue impact to those named agencies.
