Research Analysis

The policy committee recommendation to HB 3270 requires the State Board of Agriculture to promulgate rules for the testing and interstate movement of feral swine. This measure requires all persons transporting feral swine in the state to obtain a transporter license from the Oklahoma Department of Agriculture, Food, and Forestry (ODAFF). This measure limits the transportation of feral swine to a licensed handling facility or directly to an approved slaughter facility. This measure also limits the release of feral swine except when utilizing a Judas pig tagging system.
