Research Analysis

HB 3288, as introduced, increases the amount of physical education schools must provide to elementary school students, from 60 minutes per week to 150 minutes per week. This requirement is in addition to the pre-existing requirement for 60 minutes of recess each week. The measure strongly encourages elementary schools provide two 15-minute recesses each day. Elementary schools are prohibited from withholding physical education as a form of punishment, except if the disciplined student has exhibited threatening behaviors. During end of year assessments, elementary schools must try to provide recess right before the test.

The measure further requires students in grades 6-12 to receive an average of 225 minutes of physical education each week.
