Research Analysis

The policy committee substitute 1 to HB 3301 removes the definitions of "sawed-off shotgun" and "sawed-off rifle" from the definitions found in the Definitions for Firearms Act. The measure provides that persons in possession of a shotgun or rifle that is not in compliance is guilty of a misdemeanor, punishable by a fine of up to \$500 or imprisonment for up to 1 year in the county jail, or both fine and imprisonment. The measure provides that it is lawful to own or possess any firearm or suppressor that is lawfully possessed under federal law.
