Research Analysis

The policy committee substitute 2 to HB 3301 removes the definitions of "sawed-off shotgun" and "sawed-off rifle" from the definitions in the Definitions of Firearms Act. The measure provides that a person in possession of a rifle or shotgun not in compliance is guilty of a misdemeanor punishable by a fine of up to \$1,000, imprisonment in the county jail for up to 1 year, or both fine and imprisonment. The measure provides that it is permissible to own or possess a firearm or suppressor lawfully possessed pursuant to the National Firearms Act.
