HB 3336 as introduced, removes the salary range for the Chief Information Officer, which is set at \$130,000 to \$160,000.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3336 amends statutory language to remove the salary minimum and maximum caps for the Chief Information Officer. Per OMES, this will allow for more flexible compensation based on state needs and market conditions. Such flexibility could attract a wider range of candidates, enhancing the state's IT management capabilities and strategies. The amended salary range was established in 2009. The measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
