**Research Analysis**

The second proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3338 directs the Construction Industries Board to issue and regulate swimming pool contractor licenses. By November 1, 2027, the board must establish requirements for experience, training, continuing education, and examinations to obtain the license. The initial license fee is \$500, with an annual renewal fee of \$300. A swimming pool contractor license does not authorize an individual to perform electrical or plumbing work beyond standard pool installation or connected to a public water supply, sanitary sewer, or electrical service.
