Research Analysis

HB 3383 as introduced, prohibits state employees from being required to work more than 14 hours per day except in the event of an officially declared emergency. The provisions of this measure apply to regular and overtime hours.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3383 creates new law limiting state employees to no more than fourteen (14) hours worked in any rolling 24-hour period. After communication with multiple state agencies, including the Department of Corrections and Department of Mental Health and Substance Abuse, the findings do not result in new requirements, operational changes, or additional administrative costs. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
