**Research Analysis**

HB 3390, as introduced, requires the Department of Human Services (DHS) to update and maintain its Provider Search website that locates agencies that provide services for the Home and Community Based programs listed in the measure. The website must also include a rating system, inspection reports, substantiated complaints, administrator information, and a form to be used to report an issue with an agencies. DHS will require agencies to update information annually.
