Research Analysis

HB 3417 as introduced, clarifies that a city council can prescribe requirements and procedures for competitive bidding and that they are also subject to the provisions of Title 61 Section 140 should HB 3418 become effective. The measure also recodifies [Title 11 Section 17-115](#), which relates to reverse auction bidding, as Title 61 Section 141.

Fiscal Analysis

House Bill 3417 amends county competitive bidding and purchasing procedures. By requiring compliance with Title 61, § 140 in addition to county purchasing statutes, the measure clarifies that counties must meet statewide competitive bidding requirements alongside local procedures. The measure deals exclusively with process and compliance for local county level government and is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
