**Research Analysis**

HB3436, as introduced, creates a verification requirement for the state and its political subdivision prior to buying any electric vehicle. The measure requires the purchasing entity to verify with the manufacturer that no child labor was used in the assembly of the vehicle or the production of its component prior to purchase.

**Fiscal Analysis**

House Bill 3436 imposes a new verification requirement in state procurement of electric vehicles. Any administrative workload associated with verifying child labor compliance is expected to be managed within current agency operations. Therefore, the measure is not anticipated to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
