Research Analysis

HB 3443 as introduced, authorizes the Oklahoma Department of Transportation to increase oversize or overweight permit fees. Several oversize and overweight permit fees are increased as outlined in the measure.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure raises certain fines and fees that are all deposited into the Weigh Station Improvement Revolving Fund. According to the Oklahoma Department of Transportation (ODOT), it believes the total revenue increase to the fund will be about \$15,000,000.00 a year. Most of this increase should go towards constructing, equipping, and maintaining the weigh station facilities across the state.

Other Considerations

Currently, the Weigh Station Improvement Fund, has a purpose of constructing, equipping, and maintain weigh station facilities. Before ODOT receives the funds those, the fund is currently apportioned as the first \$20,000,000.00 goes to the General Revenue Fund (47 O.S. §14-122). The next \$1,216,000.00 is apportioned to the Oklahoma Tax Commission, then \$2,500,000.00 is apportioned to the Department of Public Safety for staffing officers at the weigh stations, and then \$3,716,000.00 is to be used for motor carrier permitting systems and motor carrier safety and enforcement (47 O.S. §14-116). Anything raised above those thresholds then is in the account for ODOT to use towards the original purpose of the fund.
