Research Analysis

The committee amendment to HB3448 changes the changes the amount of a group home's general liability insurance coverage from \$1 million to \$100,000 for each occurrence of damage to off-site personal property.

HB 3448 provides that a group home must maintain general liability insurance coverage of at least \$100,000 for each occurrence of damage to off-site personal property. An insurance policy or contract must cover damage to offsite personal property that occurs while the child is in the care of the group homes. The Department of Human Services must make rules providing for a standard form confirming that the group home has an insurance policy that meets the requirements of the measure. This form must be completed annually and must be maintained by the group home. The insurance policy or contract must be maintained at all times. The prevailing party in a civil action will be entitled to attorney fees and costs.
