**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3530 requires licensees under the Oklahoma Alcoholic Beverage Control Act to keep books and records regarding alcoholic beverage for three years and to make them available for inspection upon request. Once an authorized representative of the ABLE Commission or the Oklahoma Tax Commission requests this information, the licensee must make the records available within 10 business days of the request.
