**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3585 provides that any party may order a transcript from proceedings electronically recorded but only transcripts prepared by an official court reporter can be used in any subsequent trials, hearings, proceedings, or appeal. The measure adds to the list of certifications that a court reporter may attain to be eligible for additional salary by including certification as a Certified Verbatim Reporter, Certificate of Merit, Realtime Verbatim Reporter, or other certifications authorized by the Supreme Court. The measure also recognizes stenomask shorthand as a valid certification.
