Fiscal Analysis

The SUBREC to HB3585 modifies court reporter duties, compensation, and certification requirements. The measure expands the methods by which court reporters can record proceedings, removes the prohibition on certification of persons who rely exclusively upon a steno-mask, clarifies the use of electronically recorded proceedings when no court reporter is available, and modifies certification and continuing education requirements. While the current version of the measure references existing compensation amounts and fund sources, the SUBREC does not change the compensation structure or create new fiscal obligations as compared to previous versions of the measure. The Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) has confirmed that any administrative costs associated with implementing the modified certification and continuing education requirements are expected to be absorbed in accordance with the normal duties of the agency. Therefore, in its current form, the SUBREC to HB3585 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
