**Research Analysis**

The committee substitute for HB 3586 creates the "Right to Raise Act," which provides that no person will be denied the opportunity to become an adoptive parent or have the adoption denied or delayed based on the parent's refusal, unwillingness, or lack of support for a gender transition. The measure also adds that raising a juvenile consistent with their biological sex or referring to them consistent with their biological sex will not constitute child abuse or neglect or child endangerment.
