Fiscal Analysis

The CS to HB3606 authorizes certain persons to petition the court for removal from sex offender registration requirements under specific circumstances. The measure establishes petition procedures for individuals convicted of certain offenses who meet age-gap criteria, as well as registrants with permanent medical or cognitive conditions that impair their ability to comply with registration requirements. Any costs associated with processing these petitions through the court system are expected to be absorbed in accordance with the normal duties of the agencies involved. Therefore, in its current form, the CS to HB3606 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
