**Research Analysis**

As introduced HB 3627 creates the Oklahoma Agriculture Right to Repair Act. Defines terminology within the act. Requires original equipment manufacturers to make documentation, parts and tools required for diagnosis, maintenance, or repair to be available via an authorized repair provider or equipment manufacturer. Prohibits equipment manufacturers from:

- Preventing the installation or functioning of any otherwise functional part;
- Inhibiting or reducing the functioning of any part or board-level component;
- Creating false or misleading alerts or warnings about parts;
- Charging additional fees or increased prices for future repairs;
- Or, limiting who can purchase documentation, parts, and tools or perform repair services.

Grants the Attorney General the authority to enforce this act. Provides exceptions for original equipment manufacturers. Applies to equipment manufactured or sold on or after the effective date of this act.
