HB 3619, as introduced, requires the State Geographic Information Council to create a workgroup that establishes authoritative county boundaries. Further, the Office of Geographic Information is required to biennially conduct leaf-off aerial imagery to update the county boundary data layer.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3619 requires the Office of Geographic Information, housed within the Oklahoma Conservation Commission, to conduct leaf-off aerial imagery biennially to update authoritative jurisdictional county boundary data, subject to the availability of funds. The Conservation Commission estimates that the cost to conduct full-state aerial imagery to be One Million, Five Hundred Thousand dollars (\$1,500,000.00). This impact would require additional appropriated funding to go to the agency during the years the imagery is conducted.
