**Research Analysis**

Committee amendment 1 to HB3622 deletes the proposed \$500,000 appropriation to the Oklahoma Department of Commerce and creates a revolving fund for preparation activities related to the 2030 Decennial Census.

As amended, HB3622 creates the the U.S. Decennial Census Revolving Fund for the Oklahoma Department of Commerce for preparation activities related to the 2030 Decennial Census.

**Fiscal Analysis**

The committee amendment to HB 3622 removes the direct appropriation language and inserts language to create the U.S. Decennial Census Revolving Fund at the Oklahoma Department of Commerce. As part of the budget request process, the Department of Commerce has requested a recurring appropriation of Five Hundred Thousand Dollars (\$500,000.00) to prepare and administer the 2030 Census. The approval of those requested funds will be subject to the overall appropriations process. As amended, this measure has no fiscal impact to state resources.
