Research Analysis

HB 3638, as introduced, provides that, beginning with the 2027 program year, the State of Oklahoma must participate in the federal Summer Electronic Benefit Transfer for Children program to provide supplemental nutrition assistance to eligible children when school is not in session. The Oklahoma Department of Human Services will administer the program and must coordinate with the State Department of Education in determining program eligibility and facilitating program administration, including sharing data as necessary. Benefits issued under Summer EBT will be subject to the same eligible food restrictions under SNAP and implementation will be subject to available funds.
