Research Analysis

The proposed oversight committee substitute for HB 3660 requires anyone disposing of human remains by natural organic reduction to first obtain licensure from the Oklahoma Funeral Board. The measure sets standards for licensure, facility requirements, and the reduction process.

Fiscal Analysis

The proposed committee substitute to HB 3660 add natural organic reduction as a form of cremation as well as statutorily adds a Seven Hundred Fifty Dollar (\$750.00) licensing or renewal fee for natural organic reduction facilities. The measure requires licensure for any facility performing reduction services. Any fiscal impact of this measure would be applied to the Oklahoma Funeral Board, a non-appropriated state agency. Therefore, this measure has no direct fiscal or revenue considerations to FY-27 budgetary resources.
