**Research Analysis**

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3698 changes the name of the revolving fund to the "Student Eviction Assistance Pilot Program Revolving Fund." The pcs also provides that these services are provided in cities with a population of 600,000 or more and in cities with a population between 50,000 and 75,000 that are more than 60 miles from a city with a population of 400,000 or more. The pcs also amends the definition of *eligible organization* provided in the measure. The pilot program will terminate three years after the effective date of the act.
