**Research Analysis**

The amendment to the proposed committee substitute for HB 3755 clarifies that the provisions of the measure apply to a juvenile who is placed in detention and is under the Office of Juvenile Affairs's supervision or custody.

HB 3755 provides that when placing a juvenile into detention that the Office of Juvenile Affairs must provide any and all medication prescribed to the juvenile to the operator of the facility. If the medication is unavailable at time of placement, the Office must provide, at no charge to the detention center or operator, such medication no later than 48 hours after placement.
