Fiscal Analysis

The Office of Juvenile Affairs (OJA) anticipates costs associated with the 48-hour requirement to obtain a child's medication. Because youth under OJA supervision live in their own homes, the agency does not have prior knowledge of any medications they may be taking. The need to provide a medical examination and secure a prescription within this timeframe will result in added costs. As OJA provides additional details on the associated costs, this impact will be updated.
