Research Analysis

The proposed committee substitute for HB 3762 allows chiropractors to administer serums if they consist of vitamins, minerals, or other nutrients. Chiropractors who wish to inject such nutrients must apply for authorization with the Board of Chiropractic Examiners and have completed at least 120 hours of injectable procedure education from a board-approved program and passed an independent certification exam.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3762 requires chiropractors who wish to inject vitamins to obtain authorization from the Board of Chiropractic Examiners. The Board is a non-appropriated state agency; therefore, the provisions of this measure are assumed to be achievable within the Board's existing resources. As a result, this measure has no direct impact on the state budget or appropriations.
