The policy committee amendment 1 to HB 3765 increases the penalty from up to 2 years imprisonment to up to 5 years imprisonment.

Fiscal Analysis

This measure creates the new crime of alien or non-citizen person unlawfully acquiring or owning land in the state of Oklahoma either directly or indirectly through certain means for certain purposes. Persons convicted of such an offense shall be guilty of a felony punishable by imprisonment in the custody of the Department of Corrections for a term not to exceed 2 years, or by a fine not to exceed \$1,000, or by both such fine and imprisonment. Any resulting change to the revenues collected by the Administrative Office of the Courts (AOC) or change in the costs incurred by the Department of Corrections (DOC) are expected to be immaterial and/or absorbed by the agencies. Therefore, this measure in its current form is anticipated to be budget neutral.

The POLAMD1 increases the maximum incarceration time from 2 years to 5 years. This does not change the fiscal impact of the measure as described above.
