**Research Analysis**

HB 3780, as introduced, requires independent actuaries to write the annual actuarial opinions submitted by property and casualty insurance companies. If a sufficient opinion is not provided, the Insurance Commissioner must engage a qualified actuary at the company's expense to prepare supporting actuarial documents.
