HB 3784, as introduced, provides that supervision of a person who is performing medical micropigmentation may stop after that person has been supervised for 6,240 or more hours and has reported those hours to the State Board of Health.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3784 authorizes certified individuals to perform micropigmentation without physician supervision upon completing and reporting at least six thousand two hundred forty (6,240) supervised hours to the State Board of Health. The measure is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
