Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3784 allows individuals to perform unsupervised medical micropigmentation after completing at least 6,240 hours of supervised training, provided they do not use prescription medications on clients.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3784 authorizes certified individuals to perform micropigmentation without physician supervision after completing six thousand two hundred forty (6,240) supervised hours and reporting them to the State Board of Health, provided no prescription drugs are used on clients. The measure is not expected to have a direct fiscal impact on the state budget or appropriations.
