Research Analysis

HB 3785, as introduced, clarifies that complaints against roofing contractors offering unlawful compensation cannot be investigated by the registrar of the Construction Industries Board. Instead, the registrar must forward these complaints to the Insurance Department and the Office of the Attorney General for investigation and prosecution. Complaints may also be referred to the District Attorney for further action.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3785 clarifies that complaints received by the roofing registrar of the Construction Industries Board must be forwarded to the appropriate agency for investigation, enforcement, and prosecution of alleged violations.
