Research Analysis

HB 3791, as introduced, provides that a physician, including allopathic, osteopathic, and naturopathic, advanced practice nurse practitioners, and physicians assistants will have the right to prescribe, recommend, or suggest holistic or natural medicine or alternative treatments to patients under their care. There will be no repercussions to a physician treating their patient to the best of their ability. A parent or guardian will also have the right to treat their child with holistic or natural medicine or an alternative treatment without legal repercussions.
