Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3793 provides that in order for a program to qualify in Oklahoma as an approved program for registered nurses, or an LPN-to-Diploma-RN ladder program, the program must be conducted in-state at an approved technology center, a nationally accredited college, or an accredited college or university and the program must meet Oklahoma Board of Nursing standards. The length of approved diploma RN programs will be standalone diploma programs in which registered nurses will have between 1,300 and 1,500 clock hours and 330 additional clock hours of non-nursing coursework or a LPN-to-Diploma-RN ladder program in which LPNs must have 600 to 700 clock hours in nursing education in addition to 330 clock hours of non-nursing coursework.
