**Research Analysis**

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3800 streamlines language in the Roofing Contractor Registration Act to encompass residential roofing endorsements and regulations by clarifying compliance, modifying continuing education requirements, and updating fines for violations.

The measure also repeals Section 5 of [Chapter 368, O.S.L. 2025](#), which set the effective date for HB 1628 as July 1, 2026.
