Research Analysis

HB 3835 allows persons convicted of a criminal offense resulting from being a victim of trafficking to seek expungement for the offenses. Any filing fees or costs associated with the motion or petition for expungement are to be waived by the court. The procedures the court is to use to determine victimization are outlined.
