Fiscal Analysis

The POLREC to HB3845 modifies procedures for the revocation or suspension of driver licenses and permits for obligors who fail to comply with child support orders. The measure transfers administrative authority from the Oklahoma Child Support Services (OCSS) to the Child Support Services Division of the Department of Human Services (CSS) and authorizes district or administrative courts to order license revocation or suspension. Any costs associated with these procedural changes are expected to be absorbed in accordance with the normal duties of the agencies involved. Therefore, in its current form, the POLREC to HB3845 is not anticipated to have a material impact on state budget or appropriations.
