Research Analysis

The proposed policy committee substitute for HB 3884 removes a few provisions from the Providers' Bill of Rights. It removes a provision that a resident's contract can be terminated after a 30 day notice for just cause, a provision that says they can refuse a consumer inappropriately referred to the facility, and a provision that they have the right to maintain an environment free of weapons and drugs.

HB 3884 creates the "Providers' Bill of Rights Act of 2026," which outlines rights held by assisted living facilities under the Continuum of Care Act. Each assisted living facility must post the document in a prominent place in the facility.
