Research Analysis

The polpcs2 for HB 3884 adds that the Providers' Bill of Rights provides assurance that nothing in the document will diminish, impair, or conflict with resident rights established under state or federal law. It also adds that individuals are treated in a professional manner and that a facility must comply with all requirements when terminating a resident's contract. Facilities have the right to establish and enforce policies governing the possession of weapons and unlawful drugs within the facility. Facilities must continue to prominently post the Resident Bill of Rights as required by state law.

HB 3884 creates the "Providers' Bill of Rights Act of 2026," which outlines rights held by assisted living facilities under the Continuum of Care Act. Each assisted living facility must post the document in a prominent place in the facility.
