HB 3886, as introduced, provides that in the case of an immediate jeopardy determined with respect to a nursing facility that State Department of Health personnel remain on site until the nursing facility's Plan of Removal is accepted.

Fiscal Analysis

HB 3886 requires State Department of Health (OSDH) personnel to remain on site at a nursing facility during an immediate jeopardy determination until the facility's Plan of Removal is accepted.

According to OSDH, occasions requiring nurses to remain on-site are expected to be rare; therefore, no additional FTEs are necessary. In its current form, HB 3886 is not expected to have a direct impact on the state budget.
